

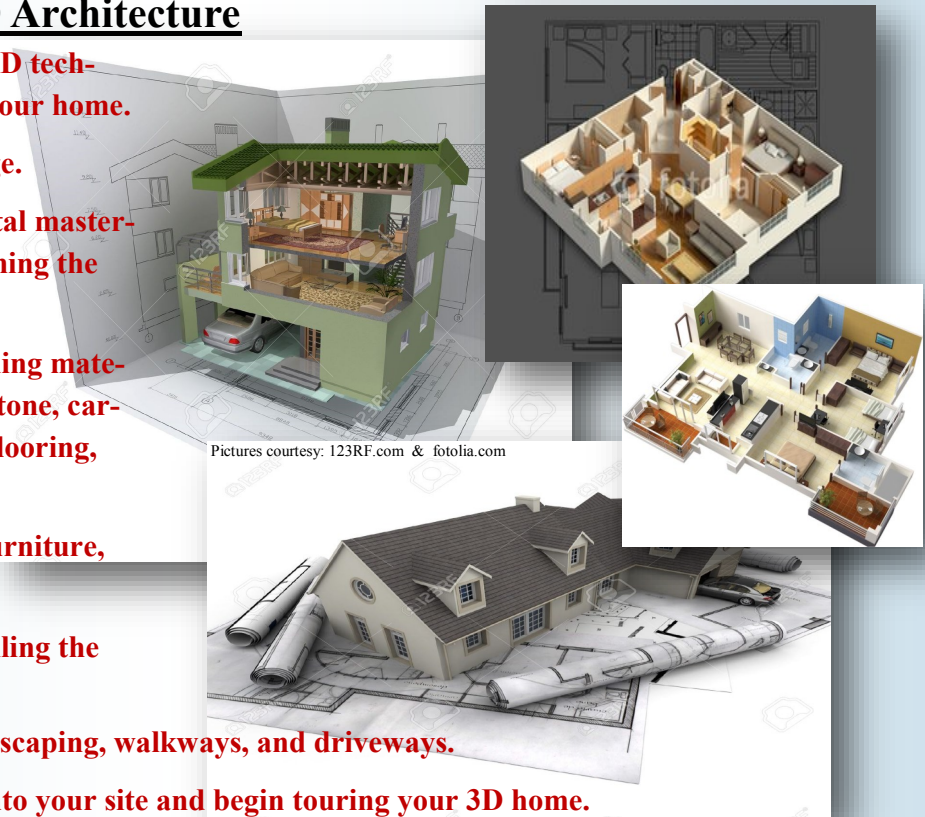

## Step by Step Benefits to 3D Architecture

1. **Develop Architectural drawings – 2D technical plans for the construction of your home.**
2. **Plan your door and window package.**
3. **Turn your 2D design into a 3D digital masterpiece. Here's where you start becoming the interior decorator.**
4. **Customize interior & exterior building materials and finishes: woodwork, tile, stone, carpeting, wall finishes, siding, paint, flooring, trim, cabinets, and fireplace etc.**
5. **Consider the type and location of furniture, appliances, and fixtures.**
6. **Develop a 2D and 3D site map detailing the topography of the building site.**
7. **Decide on your site placement, landscaping, walkways, and driveways.**
8. **Place the 3D model of your build onto your site and begin touring your 3D home.**
9. **Virtually walk from room to room examining both finish and structural details. Examine how sunlight enters your home through windows and doors. Some designers can also alter sunlight according to different times of the day.**
